Step 1: Be prepared to protect nature before you go outdoors

- Play a wildlife game with your friends and family: In the first box draw a creature you might see at the Reserve (ex. birds) and in the second box draw wildlife you probably will not see (ex. Lions)

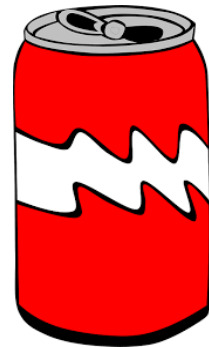
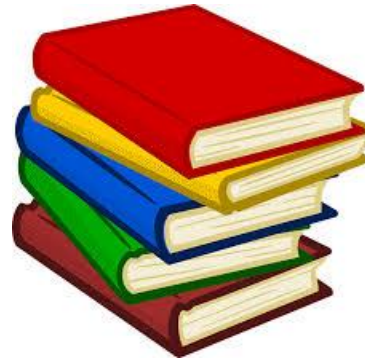
